Gilmore dominates Bells Beach

Gilmore has dominated Saturday's finals to reclaim the Rip Curl Pro women's title at Bells Beach. Gilmore posted the highest scores in the quarter-finals and semis and then beat former world champion Sofia Mulanovich in the final. The 22-year-old Australian, who has won the last three world titles, beat the Peruvian 14.67 to 10.00 in the final. Gilmore had previously won at Bells in 2007 and '08 and lost last year's final to Brazilian Silvana Lima. In-form Australian Chelsea Hedges beat Lima on Saturday morning in the quarter-finals, but then lost to Mulanovich in the semi-finals by the narrowest-possible margin. Mulanovich and Hedges were tied at 10.50 and the Peruvian won on a count-back. Hedges needed a score of 5.18 on the last wave of their semi-final to win and she scored a 5.17. There were no such concerns on Saturday for Gilmore, who nearly blew her round-three heat on Friday against teenager Tyler Wright. Gilmore had the highest quarter-final heat score of 17.34 on Saturday to easily beat compatriot Rebecca Woods's 4.56. While Hedges and Mulanovich had a nail-biting semi, Gilmore reached the final by scoring 13.50 to beat Australian Sally Fitzgibbons, who posted 10.50.
